Thank you all for your heartfelt messages and concern for the victims of the tsunami disaster. I am especially touched by the overwhelming outpour of sympathy from Zontians all over the world. In view of the unprecedented loss of human life and devastation of the environment in District 17, I appeal to you for relief assistance for the tsunami victims in Phuket, Pang Nga,

Krabi, Trang, Ranong and Satul (Thailand), Langkawi (Malaysia), Aceh (Indonesia) as well as the flood victims in Quezon and Nueva Ecija (Philippines). The best way to contribute is through international relief agencies with special disaster expertise working on ground in the affected areas, such as


