SERVICE/ STATUS OF WOMEN COMMITTEE NEWS



Zonta Club of Denver General Meeting Minutes January 12, 2006

The meeting was called to order at 6:05pm at the American Legion post in Edgewater. President-elect Sheila Davis presided.

Invocation: Cathy Conley gave the invocation.

Guests: Carol Walton was the guest of Linda Rhea.

Program: In lieu of a speaker, members stayed after the business meeting to make tied baby blankets for the Denver Kids Teen Moms program.

Minutes: November minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Membership: Cathy Conley presented Marjorie Pickett with an engraved crystal Zonta rose box. She also presented two items from Zonta International: the first a Certificate of Commendation signed by President Mary Ellen Bittner, the second a congratulatory letter from the Executive Director. Marjorie thanked the club for the events celebrating her 50th anniversary with Zonta.

There was discussion about continuing to meet at the Sheraton Four Points or changing to another location. Possibilities include the Executive Tower Inn downtown, Hyatt Tech Center, Embassy Suites on Hampden, and various locations in the Stapleton area. Julie Bradley and Cathy Conley are evaluating options and are open to suggestions.

The Amelia Earhart dinner is scheduled for January 19th at the Lakewood Elks Club. There was discussion about inviting a teacher and/or student guest. Jacki Sammons made a motion that the club use unallocated service funds to pay for three people to attend. Sheila Davis seconded and the motion passed.

Service: Beth Mundell presented the Service Committee's grant recommendations. She emphasized the committee's focus on projects benefiting the status of women, in keeping with the club mission statement. Funding for the Imagination Library was previously approved. There was discussion about losing sponsor status with Denver Kids, Inc. The current grant proposal reduces the operating expenses donation, but gives program money for Teen Moms. Jacki Sammons made a motion to approve the service committee's recommendations for the allocation of club service funds and club raffle money, and to accept the trustees' allocations to Zonta International foundations and local service funds. Kathy Hyzer seconded and the motion passed.

Beth plans to poll the membership about continued service to The Gathering Place.

Fundraising: The club is selling tickets to The Female Odd Couple production at the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center on Sunday, February 12th. Prices are \$24 and \$30, including \$10 per ticket for the club. Sheila Davis will e-mail information to members and to Area 3 presidents. Reservations are being made for an optional dinner after the show at the Melting Pot.

Fall Shopping Spree

The fundraising committee spent a significant amount of time discussing feedback from members, vendors, and themselves on the Fall Shopping Spree. The committee voted on whether or not to have a shopping spree again this year based on the time spent and the money made (\$2,700). The vote was evenly split. Two options regarding 2006 fundraisers were then developed as follows:
