### JANUARY, 2015 Year in Review - Gender Equality in 2014



From the passing of one of the Arab region's most progressive constitutions enshrining women's rights (Tunisia) to changes in legislation to provide long overdue redress to wartime survivors of sexual violence, this year there were a number of gender equality achievements, milestones and noteworthy moments from around the world to celebrate.

For example, two years ago, a 16-year-old Morroccan girl committed suicide after being forced to marry her alleged rapist to uphold her family's honor. Such marriages were encouraged by the Morrocco penal code provision that enabled a rapist to avoid prosecution if he married his underage victim. Last January, the Morrocco parliament repealed that provision of the penal code.




