## **PUBLIC RELATIONS**

#### Why does ZCD Need PR?

Zonta International recently held a teleconference on PR building blocks, and it seemed we all might benefit from a refresher. So here are some notes. You don't need to be a PR PhD to help get the word out about our mission and club.

If you've ever talked about ZCD to a friend, only to have them say, "who?" you know why we need consistent and frequent PR. We don't need to try to make ZCD as recognizable as George and Amal Clooney, just a little less of a secret than it is today. And as someone famous has said, this is not rocket surgery.



In any group of people, your experience with Zonta may make you a resource on increasing women's abilities to become self-sufficient. If you're talking to a person who seems to be interested in causes or issues that touch on Zonta's mission or our club activities, mention ZCD's grants to local groups. If you're asked about what you spend time and effort on, proudly talk about ZCD's efforts toward improving opportunities for women.

You'll sense whether someone is interested in getting more information, or becoming involved at some level. Meet them at that level with the website address, an invitation to an activity or a meeting, or, if someone seems particularly interested in how they can help, mention the Day of Film sponsorship opportunities, and connect them via email with your personal introduction to a Fundraising Committee member.

This is grass-roots level PR. Your ZCD PR team will soon be sending out information about our grants dinner in February and the Day of Film in March. We'll share the release, which can be a good one-pager to tell people about our club.
